A cooler growing season overall and a dry late harvest season yielded high acid and full fruit, making for a fully ripe vintage. The conditions of this vintage have created wines that are balanced, with full fruit and bright acid.

In 2022, our vineyard produced the right lignification of shoots to craft a special and intentional whole cluster offering. Full maceration, and fermented to dryness on stems and skins, our Whole Cluster was aged for 15 months in neutral French Oak.
